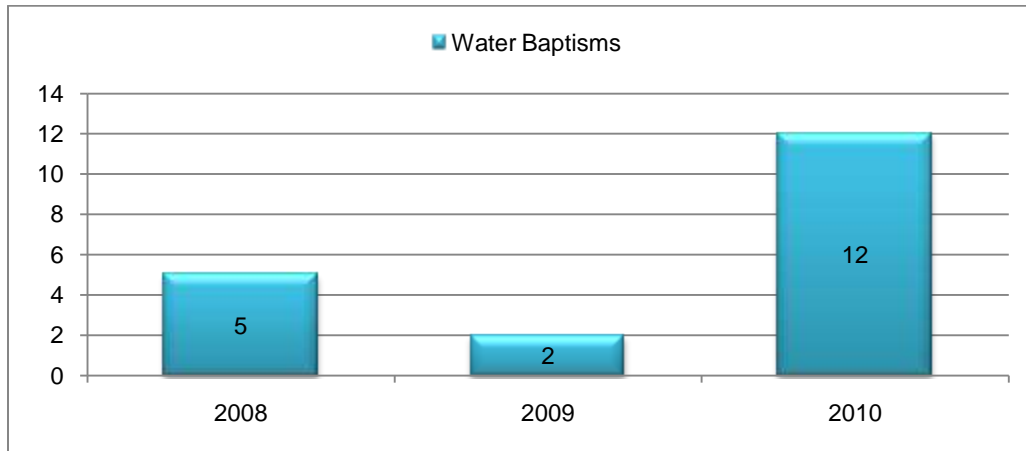
Received Altar Prayer/Ministry

In 2010, 522 people received prayer and ministry at TCC during our Sunday Morning Services.

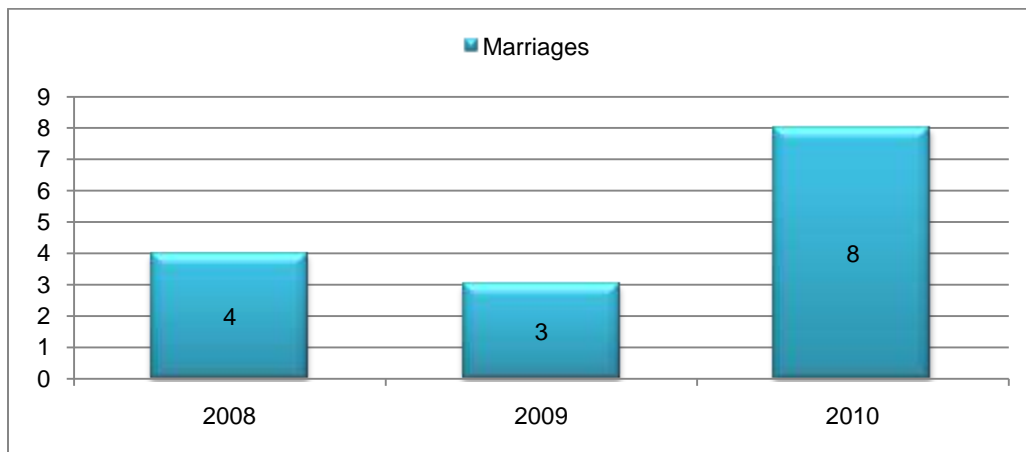

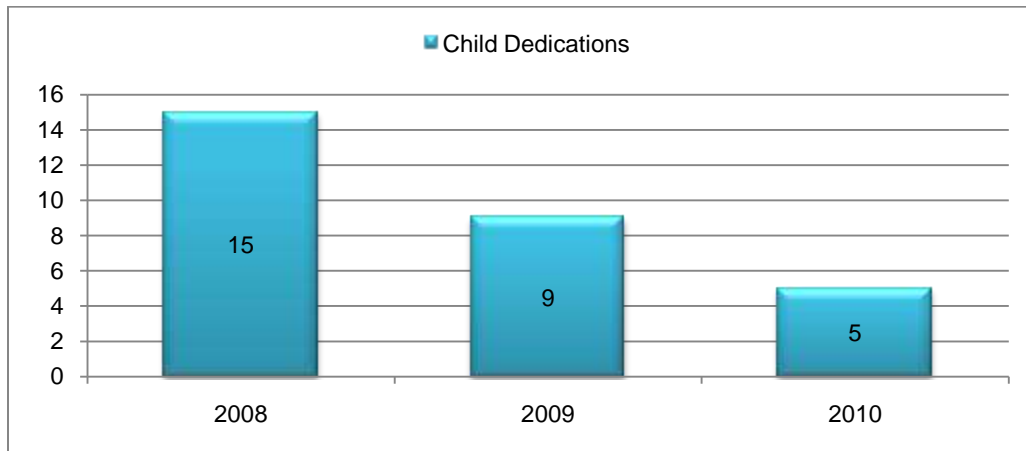

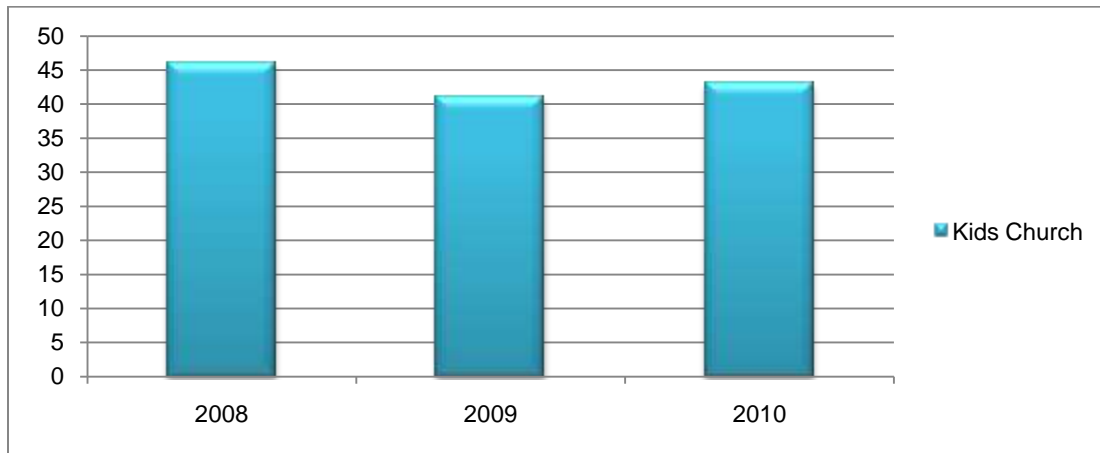

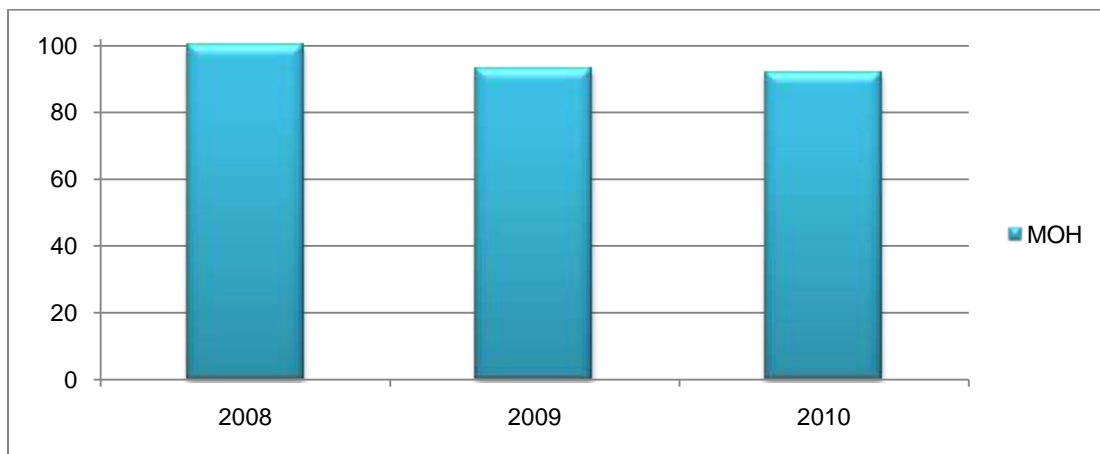

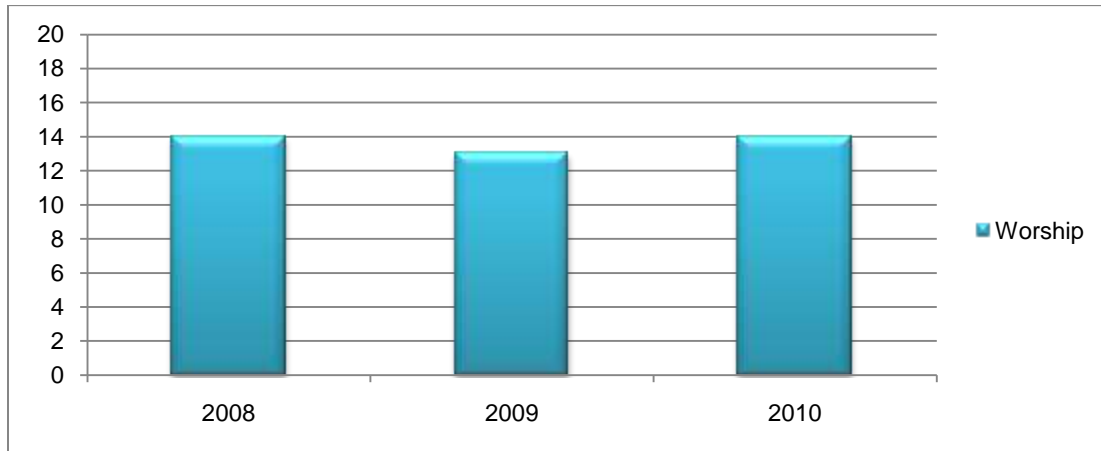

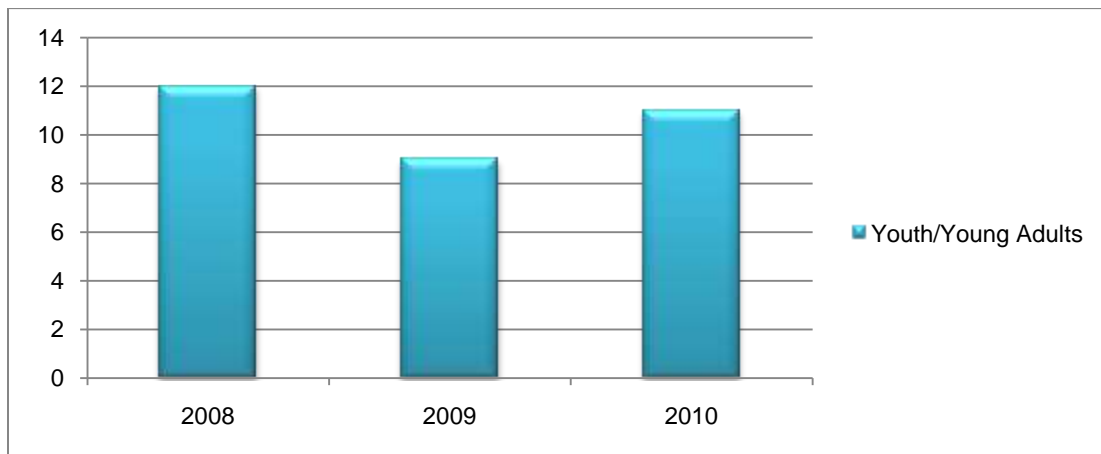

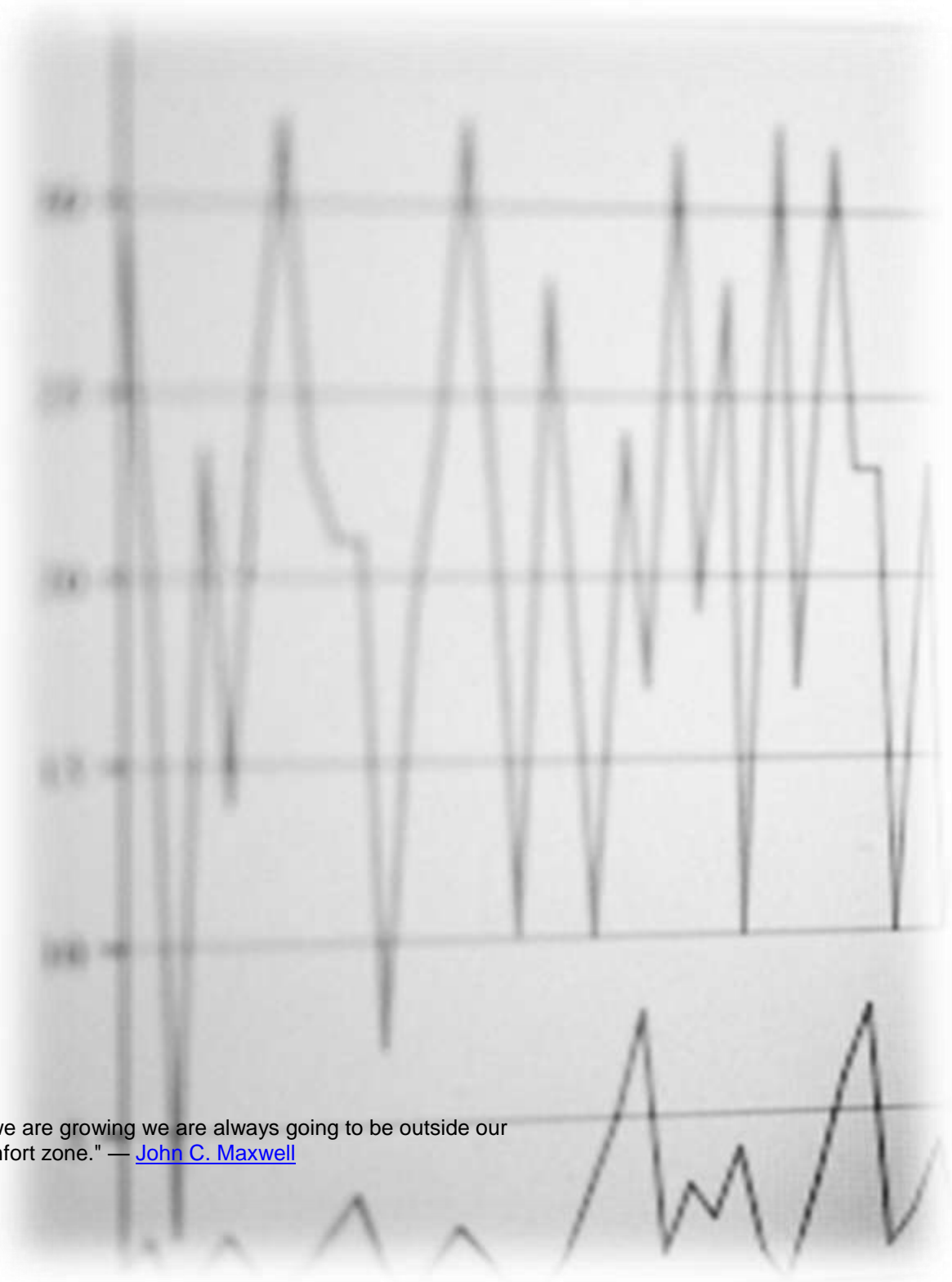

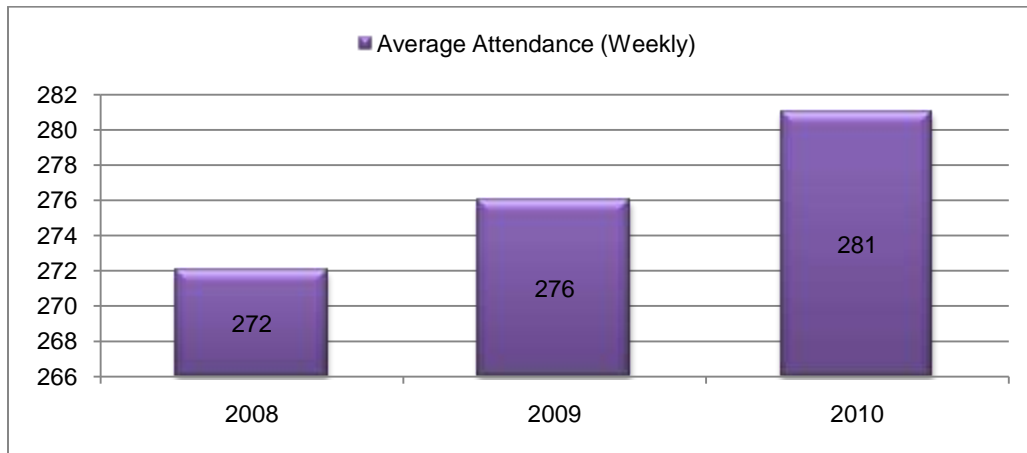

Average Attendance (Cumulative)

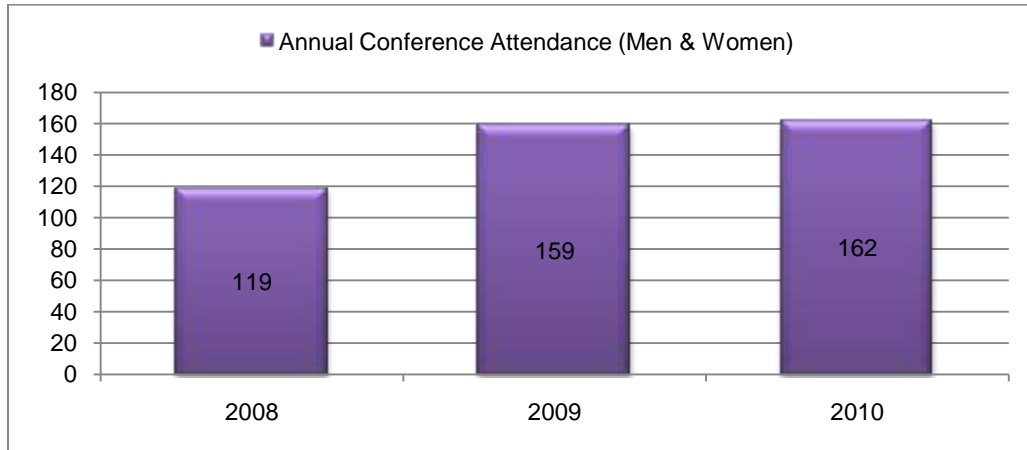


Weekly Average Attendance



Executive Board Report

2010 was an eventful and blessed year for TCC. We continue to enjoy the support of a committed and faithful congregation. The Board continues to covet your prayer support and servant hearts as we continue to govern TCC on your behalf.

2010 Highlights:

- Met June deadline under Site Plan Agreement between TCC and the City for beginning construction on the new church building.
- Ground breaking ceremony was held in early June to celebrate the start of construction.
- Addressed subsequent Site Plan issues by completing revisions to the architectural drawings for the new church building to incorporate phasing into the building process and submission to the City of the revised drawings for the purpose of having issued an amendment to our Site Plan and a revised Building Permit.
- Toronto City Sports Centre being fully booked for all prime time hours and most of the other available hours for the full season of September 2010 – April 2011.
- Undertaking changes in the Board of TCC, including Pastor Steve Yuke as President, Vijay Selvadurai as Treasurer and Darren Griffith as Secretary.
- We commissioned the following people to be on the Church Council: Pastors Mario/Hilda Cupeta, Mark/Annie Goodaire, Jair/Norma Guerrero, Robin/Ruth Machanda, Denny/Michelle Medeiros, Francis/Sanna Miclat and Ron/Nenita Warr. Les/Julie Bertram and Don/ Anne Brophy were commissioned to the Church Council as well as Elders.
- The recognition of TCC group leaders as Deacons.

We are thankful that during the year under review TCC was blessed by God's grace and favor, We have seen great things take place at TCC and expect to see more as people's lives are changed.

In 2010, the Dome experienced a successful year of operation and received much appreciation from its users and community participants.

Toronto City Church maintained a sound financial position. The financial records for the year reflected an excess of revenue over expenditure of approximately \$424,406 and net assets amounted to \$ 5.6 million.

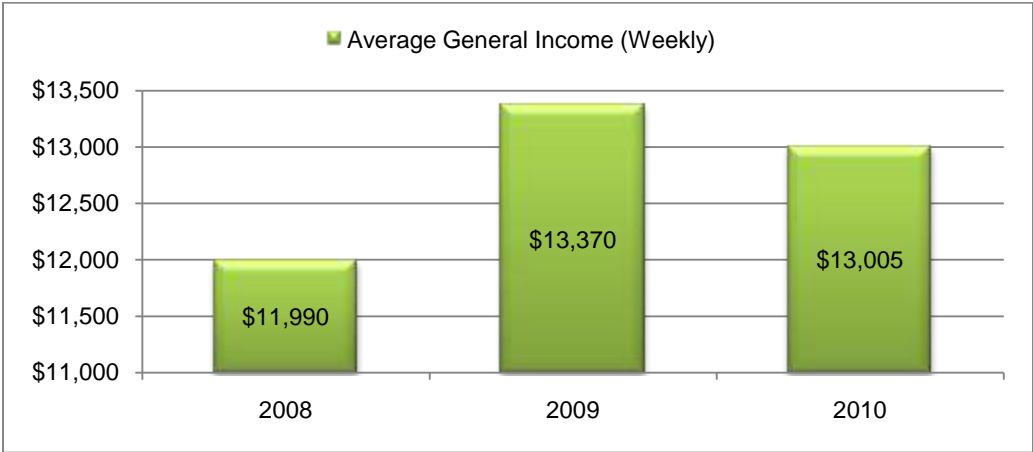

TCC is currently in the process of finalizing the construction loan with the bankers for Phase Two, and we look forward to occupying our new facility and impacting the community and the GTA.

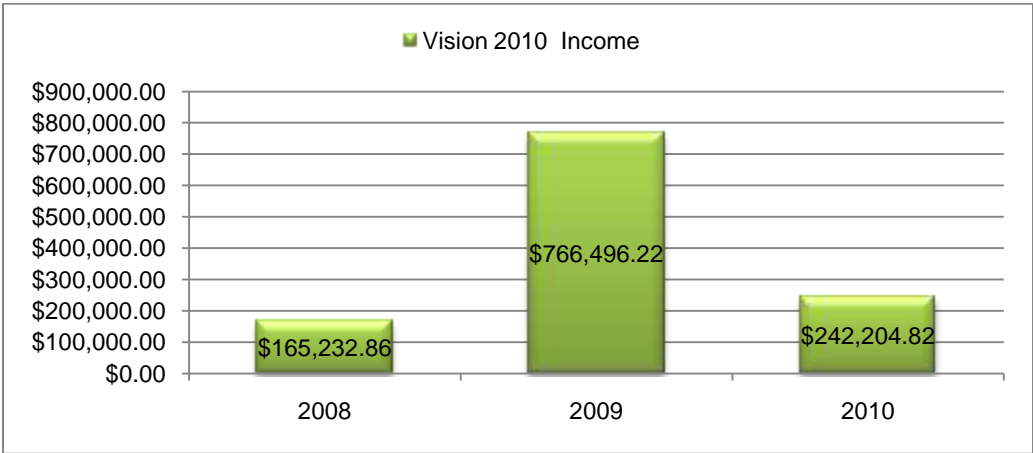

Average General Income (Weekly)



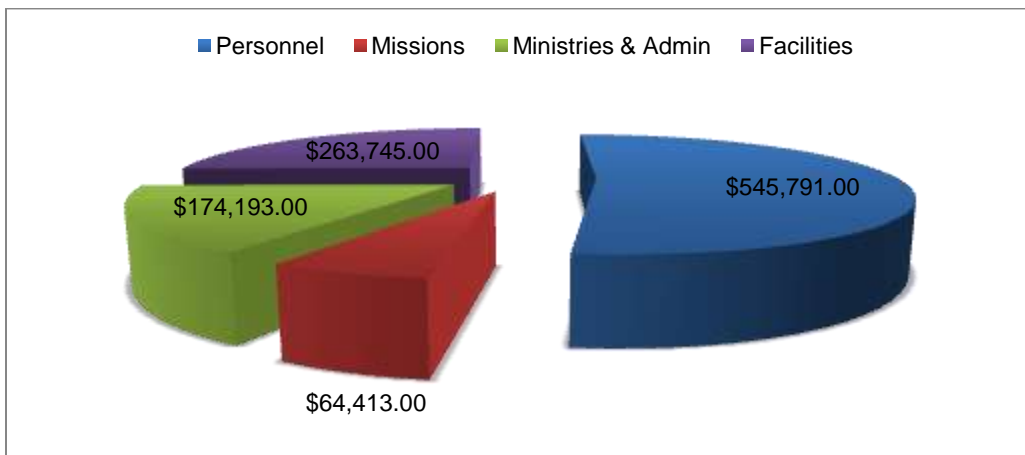
Vision 2010 Income

Apostolic Missions is a vital ministry which utilizes the wisdom and experience of seasoned pastors to resource, assist and “come alongside” pastors, leaders and churches/ministries locally, provincially, nationally and abroad.

Positionally, Pastor Paul serves as National Apostolic Facilitator and a Director of Open Bible Faith Fellowship, and as the Canadian Board Member of Church Growth International. In addition, many pastors and leaders in the Greater Toronto Area and provincially, in Ontario and Quebec, look to us for assistance and pastoral covering.

The scope of this ministry includes not only the ministry at other locations, but a lot of time on the phone and by email counseling, encouraging, motivating, problem solving and giving advice. It also involves many hours spent in intercession on others' behalf. As well, there is a good amount of time directed to networking with other ministry organizations/individuals in an ongoing effort to strengthen the Body of Christ so that it can have a stronger, more unified impact for the cause of Christ.

Here is a brief overview of the types of activities we do:

- Visiting churches
- Meet with/ resource pastors and organizational leaders
- In addition, we do Encounters, Growth Days for pastors, serve at conferences, OBFF Director Meetings, CGI Board Meetings, conduct OBFF membership interviews, attend City prayer meetings, attend/resource outside events, etc. It is our joy to serve wherever we can.

Since 2009, we have been part of a GTA Apostolic Eldership Team. This is a multi-ethnic team of seasoned men and women from various church backgrounds with a deep passion and calling to see our city, not only impacted by God, but transformed in all the seven spheres of influence, for the glory of God. Working in conjunction with Mission GTA, we serve as apostolic covering for the GTA region churches; to impart vision, to stand in the gap for and guard over the pastors/churches, impart God's plans for the city, motivate, exhort, encourage and strengthen the pastors in the GTA.

As apostles take their place, encouraging pastors to work together as one body, the kingdom of God will be greatly advanced. It is our desire that His will and purposes be done in our city, province and nation, as it is throughout the earth.

We are blessed to have the honor of serving our city alongside the awesome people of Toronto City Church, who share our passion and commitment to see this city won to God. To God be the glory!

Mark Davy is the founder and president of Global Harvest Ministries International (GHMI). His mission focus is the Islamic nations of North Africa and the Middle East where he travels several times a year holding mass crusades and demonstrating the power of God through signs, wonders and miracles.

Teen Challenge

Teen Challenge is a 12-month, faith-based, residential drug and alcohol rehabilitation program that is part of a network of over 15 Teen Challenge Centres across Canada, and more than 1,000 worldwide. The program has a strong faith-based approach and offers spiritual, academic and vocational training that helps equip individuals to return to society as responsible citizens.

- Teen Challenge Alberta and Atlantic Canada, filled to capacity.
- Successful tours by the National Teen Challenge Choir in Alberta and a speaking team in Newfoundland, proclaimed the Gospel and promoted the Teen Challenge Program.
- Teen Challenge received over 2200 calls for help.
- Teen Challenge welcomed over 215 Young Adults into their programs and provided:
 - 47,450 nights of lodging and care
 - 166,075 hot meals for students
 - 16,380 hours of life coaching and training
 - 110,220 hours of biblical and educational training

Good News Ministry Mauro and Connie Girgenti

Pastor Mauro has travelled all over Italy and in different parts of Europe holding evangelistic meetings. This past year many people received Jesus as their Savior and have been filled with the Holy Spirit.

- In our main church in Verona, Italians are being born again and baptized in the Holy Spirit every week.
- Over 100 ministers follow our ministry, and leaders from all over Italy attend these seminars.
- We have trained over 200 ministers in our bible school who are either pastoring a church or are in the ministry of helps.
- You have helped us translate and print over 48 books titles in Italian
- More than 190,000 copies of these books have been distributed not only in Italy, but also in other parts of Europe, North America and Australia.
- Our ministry works with 5 children's foster homes in the city of Verona. We regularly send them food, clothing and medicine and we also supply food to a homeless shelter that feeds over 1000 people a month.
- A church and bible school were established in Athens Greece. All of our materials were translated into Greek.

Rock Church Halifax India Full Gospel Bible College

We want to thank the TCC family for your ongoing support of the India Full Gospel Bible College.

The India Full Gospel Bible College was founded by the late Rev. Dr. Gideon & Mrs. Ida

Nickelson. In obedience to the call of God to start a Bible School in the 1960's, Dr. Gideon Nickelson began to pray daily that the Bible College would be established to train men to be faithful ministers of God. The Lord granted his petition and enabled him to start the Bible College with eight students in a small rented house on August 22, 1983. Gideon and his son, Monovah continued to pray with the students for a larger building. The Lord answered their prayers, and through the partnership of Rock Church, under the leadership of Pastors Ted and Paul Yuke at that time, a beautiful building was built. The Bible College is located on a two acre site in K. G. F. (Kolar Gold Fields). It was dedicated on February 10, 1989.

Well over 700 graduates have been commissioned from the India Full Gospel Bible College and are presently serving the Lord as church planters, pastors, evangelists and missionaries in various parts of India, including Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, New Delhi, and Mizoram.

2010 saw another class of graduates commissioned to ministry in various parts of India.

Your support helped us with much needed maintenance at the Bible School and property, including complete painting of all dorm rooms, renovating and repair of all student bath facilities and replacement of the solar water heater, enabling students to receive hot water to their rooms, a luxury taken for granted by us here in North America. We are eternally grateful for your support and thank you all very much!
